- 11 Rationale: Without careful reading of 9.6.1, this could be interpreted to mean that the wait
- 12 interrupts and stops a data transfer operation.
- 13 Richard rejects this on the grounds that the cross-reference is to a data transfer statement rather
- than to a data transfer operation. I still believe that the text in the document is open to
- 15 misinterpretation and would benefit from clarification. Any advice from /jor would be gratefully
- 16 received.
