1 1 Introduction

- 2 This paper proposes additional functionality parallel to the capability recently introduced by J3-016 to
- 3 consider a disassociated pointer that is associated with a nonpointer optional dummy argument to be
- 4 not present. Briefly, it proposes that a dummy argument that is not present can be the target of a
- 5 pointer assignment, in which case the pointer becomes disassocicated.
- 6 Admittedly, this solves a linear-complexity problem, while the functionality in J3-016 solves an exponen-
- 7 tial-complexity problem. This proposal merely completes the symmetry of that proposal.
