## 1 Edits

2 Edits refer to 07-007r1. Page and line numbers are displayed in the margin. Absent other instructions, a  
 3 page and line number or line number range implies all of the indicated text is to be replaced by associated  
 4 text, while a page and line number followed by + (-) indicates that associated text is to be inserted after  
 5 (before) the indicated line. Remarks are noted in the margin, or appear between [ and ] in the text.

6 [Editor: Insert “data” before “pointer”.] 119:9

7 [Duplicates [19:22]. Editor: Delete the paragraph.] 120:24

---

8 [According to C406, an object of abstract declared type cannot be other than polymorphic, so C612  
 9 does nothing. Editor: Delete C612.] 121:1

---

10 [Editor: Replace “that” by “its”.] 124:7

---

11 [Editor: Continuation of Table 6.1 needs a heading.] 125:0+

---

12 [The many-one array section restriction is needlessly complicated by singling out only the two possible  
 13 cases of its appearance in a variable definition context. It would be simpler to say “variable definition  
 14 context.” The subclause would be clearer if this material were after material on the more general case.  
 15 Editor: Move “A **many-one** ... statement” to be a new paragraph at [126:10+]. Then replace “appear  
 16 ... statement” by “not appear in a variable-definition context (16.6.7)”.] 126:4-7

17 [Editor: Replace “a *type-spec*” by “*type-spec*” twice.] 128:1,5

---

18 [Editor: Delete “An unsaved ... unallocated.” since that’s covered by [130:30].] 130:35-36

---

19 [Editor: Insert “The” before “*stat-variable*”.] 133:18

---

20 [Editor: Insert “The” before “*errmsg-variable*”.] 134:4
