2 Edits refer to 07-007. Page and line numbers are displayed in the margin. Absent other instructions, a
3 page and line number or line number range implies all of the indicated text is to be replaced by associated
4 text, while a page and line number followed by + (-) indicates that associated text is to be inserted after
5 (before) the indicated line. Remarks are noted in the margin, or appear between [and] in the text.

7	In FORTRAN 77, and also for consistency in Fortran 90, formatted output to certain units	
8	resulted in the first character of each record being interpreted as controlling vertical spacing.	
9	There was no standard way to detect whether output to a unit resulted in this vertical format	
10	control, and no way to specify that it should be applied; this has been deleted. The effect	
11	can be achieved by post-processing a formatted file.
