This paper includes a comment that was in 01-204r1, which was entitled "Comments on section 7." The material to which the comment applies was moved to section 13 in 01-007r2. The line numbers in this paper apply to 01-007r2.

What if the dummy argument has assumed or deferred type parameters? At [96:11-12] and 315:27 [303:10-12], type parameter inquiry is proscribed only for deferred parameters of disassociated pointers or unallocated allocatables, so inquiring about assumed type parameters of dummy arguments is presumably OK. In order to do this, it seems the optional argument of NULL ought to be required. This is also the topic of interpretation request 19, at least in the context of assumed character length. Make sure [315:18-20] is updated if interpretation request 19 changes this.
