1 **1 Introduction**

2 The term "unsaved" has a temporal connotation, i.e., becoming "unsaved" is a process. Whether
3 a variable has the SAVE attribute is, however, a static condition. A variable does not become
4 saved, or become unsaved. When the absence of any other attribute is discussed, it has the
5 "non" prefix, not the "un" prefix. The term "unsaved" is the wrong term; it ought to be
6 "nonsaved".
