*An exception shall not signal if this could arise only during execution of a **process** further to those required or permitted by the standard*

Unresolved issue 11 took issue with the word "process". Upon reflection, it seems the most appropriate term in the standard is executable-construct (2.3.1). If the committee agrees, the text should be edited to read

*An exception shall not signal if this could arise only during execution of a **executable-construct** further to those required or permitted by the standard*

NOTE:

Withdrawn. Henry pointed out that initialization exprs need to not gratuitously signal either. Passing this would make matters worse since the text would be precise and *wrong*.
